Explanations of the top-ups

The payment of the top-ups is in addition to the regular funding scope of the ERASMUS stay.

1. Top-Up for „Green Travel“

You can apply for this top-up if you are going to travel to or from the company with one of the following means of transport classified as sustainable by the DAAD (at least 50% of the travel distance):

- Train
- Carpool
- Boat
- Bus
- Bicycle
- Walk

The amount of the funding is a one-time fee of 50 euros; in addition, there is the possibility of funding up to 4 additional travel days.

By applying, you undertake to submit proof of arrival/departure to the International Office of Stralsund University of Applied Sciences for examination upon request.

2. Social Top-Up for first-time academics

Students whose parents have not obtained an academic degree (FH or university) recognized in Germany can apply for this top-up. In the case of single parents, this regulation only applies to the respective parent with whom the child lives.

3. Social Top-Up for employed students

Students who, before starting their internship abroad, have been employed or self-employed with a fixed salary that they are unable to continue during their stay abroad are entitled to apply for this top-up.

The following applies to this top-up:	- monthly earnings €450-€850
	- Exercise: at least 6 months continuously before the start of mobility

4. Social Top-Up for students with children

Students who are traveling abroad with their child(ren) can apply for this top-up. By applying for this social top-up, you undertake to submit proof that the child belongs to you and will travel with you (e.g. proof of parental allowance and travel ticket).

The additional funds can also be granted to couples. However, double support for a child is excluded.

5. Social Top-Up for students with disabilities or chronic illness

Students with a "degree of disability (GdB)" of 20 or more or a chronic illness who are funded for an internship abroad through ERASMUS can apply for this top-up.

By applying for this social top-up, you agree to submit proof of your disability or chronic illness (e.g. confirmatory medical certificate or disability card).
